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

INGRID PARRINGTON ENGORGED IN ISLAMIC ART



The Golden Age of Islam was an era spanning over half a dozen centuries when scholarship thrived. From around the seventh century CE (first century Hijri), Islamic Caliphs centered in Baghdad pursued advancement in science, mathematics, economics, and art. As the empire's physical and cultural infrastructure spread, so did its teachings. The aniconic doctrine in the Quran and Hadith meant that creating imagery of sentient beings and deities should be avoided. In lieu of such imagery, creators of the day focused on depictions of flora, ornate calligraphy, and the development of Islamic geometric art.

The geometric art offered an aesthetically and philosophically pleasing marriage of design and doctrine that would soon be ubiquitous in the culture. Since the earliest recorded patterns in Tunisia in the mid-ninth century CE (third century Hijri), the geometric shapes evolved with each unique Islamic culture as they spanned the breadth of North Africa, the Middle East, and South Asia. Nowadays, the patterns are represented in countless mediums. You can find them in tile work, architecture, clothing, and even cell phone cases. When artist Ingrid Parrington discovered Islamic geometric art, she knew she wanted to create them in glass.

A Naval Mission Becomes a Calling

When Naval Lieutenant Commander Ingrid Parrington, a licensed physician, was tasked with a patient evaluation in Abu Dhabi in 2018, she didn't expect a life-altering discovery, but the culturally ingrained art form she witnessed there provided just that. "The therapy gym where we spent a lot of downtime had this wooden lattice with what I now know is the twelvefold rosette pattern. I spent hours each day staring at it thinking, 'What is this?' My mind was just blown.

"The geometric patterns were entrenched all over Abu Dhabi, like when we toured the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque. It was just so gorgeous with white-on-white tile work. Depending on where you are in that mosque, you can either see the pattern up close or the pattern within the pattern, like a fractal. It goes on and on. It's how you can contemplate the infinite. It got in my brain, and I couldn't get my mind off of it. I was there for work, but it ended up being a huge paradigm shift for me."

Circles, Lines, and Scale—The Hard Part

Much of contemporary Islamic geometric art is copied and pasted from classic examples onto the media of the day. Whether it be a wall tile, a necktie, dishware, or any number of items, the imagery is more often mass-produced for commerce rather than intricately drawn, and bespoke for a unique purpose. Conscious of her position as an outsider to the Islamic faith and culture, Parrington chooses the traditional route of hand drawing each of her patterns as a way to offer her respect and appreciation for the art form and underlying culture.

When Ingrid returned to her post in Bethesda, Maryland, her newfound obsession didn't fade. She became engrossed in the art form. She felt a calling when staring at the rosettes, the stars, the hexagons, and her favorite, the Hamsa. "When I got back from Abu Dhabi I thought, 'I need to learn how to draw this art, because it's so gorgeous and I don't understand it.' I invested in compasses and rulers and started doing tutorials learning how to draw the patterns. Once I felt like I had a better handle on that process, I actually signed up for a glass class."

"I really do try to be respectful with Islamic art. When you see it used in modern ways, a lot of times you can tell if someone just cut and pasted something again and again on a computer, because you can find errors in the patterns. You can see shapes that wouldn't be made if you were hand drawing it. Or something that should have been a hexagon has been turned into a rectangle, so you lose something. That's why I don't just look for patterns online and turn them into a template. That would be a lot easier, but I want to be as respectful as I can to that actual drawing and design process. I want to go from my blank sheet of paper through to the final pattern, even if I'm not the one creating the design. Someone hundreds of years ago created the design."


Building out a pattern from a blank sheet of paper is the bulk of Parrington's process. What is essentially a precisely measured series of intersecting circles and lines can take weeks to perfect. All the while, the technical aspects of cutting glass are ever-present in the back of her mind as she draws her first circles to figure out how to scale up a certain pattern. "I really enjoy creating the pattern itself. When I'm starting a new pattern, I analyze it so I can figure out how to reproduce it. It's like a big puzzle of how to get those ratios right. I usually have to try it a few times until I can crack the pattern and get the radius that really unlocks the whole thing. I'm getting better at figuring out the size that the pattern should be so that I'm not destroying my fingers trying to make these itty-bitty sized glass pieces."

Cutting the Color and Coloring Between the Lines

When Ingrid is happy with the pattern she's taken countless hours to draw, it's time to put her cutting wheel to work. Whereas the geometric pattern has been through multiple drafts over the course of weeks, working with the glass is the "easy part," taking mere days usually.

"Once I have a template and the pattern is all cut out, the glass process of cutting the glass, foiling, soldering, then the finishing steps would be only a few days' worth of work. It's all about the precision when I'm cutting the pieces. Instead of putting the glass over the pattern, using a Sharpie, and then cutting it, I put a Mylar film over the pattern, trace the pattern, number the pieces, then cut the pieces out with foil shears. I number all the pieces, because the pattern is hand-drawn. Even though the shapes are basically the same, they're still a little different, so I have to put everything in exactly where it belongs to get the best fit."

Even though her panels, lanterns, and nightlights can range from a dozen pieces up to the hundreds, Parrington barrels through the monotony of the process, all the while rife with anticipation. "It really sparks the joy of how much I love to do things that are very intricate and repetitive. A lot of what I do with geometric art is just me being so enamored with it. That's it. I don't need anything else. I just want to elevate it and get the light shining through."








Expanding the Skill Set

As if perfecting her technique in creating flawless Islamic geometrical patterns in glass weren't enough, Ingrid is always looking down different paths for what will be next. Down one avenue, she seeks to create works that combine original drawings with unique cultural aesthetics. "I recently made one while I was living in Japan that's a red sunset over the water. I drew the scene in the middle and used a geometric background based on a traditional Japanese Kumiko pattern, which is the geometric woodwork they use for their sliding doors."

Another path Parrington is pursuing brings an older interest of hers to the forefront while maintaining the Islamic art in the background, literally. Over the course of her med school education, she became intrigued with polarized light microscopy. In plain English, it's microscopic photography of crystallized chemicals under polarized light. Her old Instagram account, @minimicrogram, is dedicated to the hobby. There, you'll find vibrant microscopic pictures of different chemicals. Dopamine, sulfur, and even acetaminophen can be viewed like never imagined. She adds, "Tylenol is actually beautiful!"


Since her foray into stained glass, Ingrid has found that the imagery of polarized light microscopy lends itself well to the art of stained glass. The broken crystals are well suited to being distinct sections in a stained glass panel. Combining all of her interests is one of her main goals moving forward.

"I'm definitely going to keep the Islamic geometry as a focus. But I would like to start using more of the microscope pictures that I've taken and incorporating those within the geometry. I've done one using vitamin C with Islamic geometrical patterns in the background. I'm also currently getting into dichroic glass. I love it. I think it'll be perfect for doing microscopic crystals. The dichroic glass hits you in the face with pinks and fuchsias that are common in the polarized pictures but hard to find in stained glass colors."

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Thinking Big . . . No, Bigger

With each completed project, Ingrid's eyes get a little bigger as her confidence grows. Her largest panel to date measures 80 cm by 50 cm and incorporates some 650 pieces. Yet this no longer sates the artist as she starts to think on a larger scale.

"I'd love to go bigger and figure out how to do big installations. I don't know if it would ever happen, but if I could ever do work for a mosque, that would be incredible. I'd also love it if I could make things more 3-D. I would love to make a dichroic lantern. That will really throw the different colored light while maintaining the pattern, not just more rectangular 3-D. I also want to try making some icosahedrons so that it would take your whole visual cortex and be amazing.

Ingrid's excitement is infectious. As her portfolio grows, so does her passion for creation. It's no longer a question of if she'll make all the things she's concocted in her mind's eye, but when. "I'm going to keep making them, because I just feel like I can't not make them."



CELEBRATING THE
INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF GLASS 2022

Part of the International Year of Glass 2022, as declared by the United Nations General Assembly, includes a new exhibit, *Florida in Transformation*, at the Imagine Museum in St Petersburg, Florida. Two lamps by Preston Studios are included in the show, which lasts through October 30, 2022.

Because Jerry Preston and John Emery started creating stained glass lamps before Odyssey kits were available, the pair started right off the bat designing new original lamps when they formed Preston Studios in 1976. Early subjects never seen before like calla lilies, iris, or sea turtles caught the eyes of early collectors. The impulse was to continue this uniquely American tradition that celebrated the invention of electricity. Many are unaware that when Thomas Edison was about, you could buy two Model T Fords for the price of one Tiffany *Wisteria* lamp! Electricity, when it first became available, went only to the very wealthiest of homes. That meant a new art form was developed to celebrate this new technology. No longer was stained glass only for houses of

worship in great cathedrals. Stained glass was now meant to be lived with in the home as well. Not only was it in windows and entrances, but also in lighting.

The efforts of the Odyssey company to bring the Tiffany tradition back alive in the 20th century was timely. New methods and the new fiberglass mold forms in various shapes and sizes meant an easier way forward. For hobbyists, having the Tiffany designs embedded on the molds made their efforts to reproduce easier, but those lines on the molds are not sacred.

They can be ignored entirely if the desire is to create something new and original, as Preston Studios has done.

Taking the Tiffany Tradition into the 21st Century

The entire process of creating stained glass lamps is essentially dependent upon having a mold and tacky wax. Each piece of glass must be cut out, ground around the edges, then wrapped in copper foil before it is placed on the mold. Tacky wax is what is used to hold each piece of glass on the mold. The copper foil is what the solder will adhere to and connect all of the pieces together as a single product.

The lamp must be soldered in sections, then removed from the mold. At Preston Studios, they simply set it out under the sun for a bit until the heat melts the tacky wax. Then each section is soldered on the inside and is finally assembled by soldering the sections together inside and out. The last steps are cleaning the lamp and applying the black patina to the solder.

Before all of this practical work can be done, however, the design and visualization must take place. What is going to be the primary subject of the work? Will the design repeat itself around the shade and, if so, how many times? What lamp base will the shade be sitting on? All of these factors must be a part of the final creation, and they determine the approach needed for glass selection and coloration.

The fabulous glasses produced by such foundries as Uroboros, Lins, and Youghiogheny make it possible, in terms of quality, to rival anything produced by Tiffany, La Farge, and the various competitors in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. However, virtually any glass foundry that produces opalescent glass can be used effectively, whether it be Spectrum, Wissmach, Kokomo, or any other, depending upon the design and intent. The final artistic effect is what counts.

The approach often taken at Preston Studios is to cut out the flowers or whatever is the primary subject matter and place those pieces on the mold first. Then, top and bottom borders are cut out and placed. Next, the background is traced onto individual pieces of clear plastic with a Sharpie. Those patterns are traced onto the selected background glass and cut just inside the trace lines to fit exactly. Everything is numbered, of course, and each pattern piece is placed back on the mold until all of the glass has been ground and foiled for placement on the mold and ready to be soldered. For larger lamps, the background alone might involve well over 150 pieces.

Keep in mind that although Leonardo da Vinci almost invented, or at least made popular, the method of oil painting, not all oil paintings are called “da Vincis.” Just because Louis Comfort Tiffany outsold his competitors and had millions of dollars to work with for staff and marketing, it doesn’t mean that all of the stained glass lamps today should be simply referred to as “Tiffanys.” Some today, for example, can be referred to as “Prestons.”

Creating lamps is a passion more than it is a vocation. Hours and hours of work and thought go into every part of each project. The joy and magic happen when the completed shade is finally placed on the base and the light is turned on for the first time.

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

Keys to Creating a Market for Residential Stained Glass

It is also possible to make a living creating windows, doors, and accent panels for residential installations. Over 85 percent of the work designed and created by Preston Studios since 1976 has been exclusively for homes, but bringing the Tiffany tradition into the 21st century in windows is yet another matter. Today's homes and decor are quite different than in the 1890s through the 1930s. Even when a period look is sought after by a patron, current sensibilities must prevail in order to succeed.

What was surprising during the recent pandemic was the amount of home remodeling that proceeded, which at Preston Studios included numerous bath windows, accents, and entrances. Whether it was an entrance installation in Tortola, British Virgin Islands, or a bathroom window in Melbourne, Florida, each satisfied a particular patron's taste.



Another new market for Preston Studios is now in high-rise apartments. In fact, one commission started for a home and ended up being for a second floor apartment in Titusville, Florida. The most recent commissions in 2022 have been in apartments in a high-rise in Cocoa, Florida. The key to marketing stained glass for residences can be in working with either builders directly or interior designers. Developing relationships through a home builders association or through the local chapter of the American Society of Interior Designers can really make a difference. Over the years, Preston Studios has observed that speaking for an hour to a patron, who may be a doctor or lawyer or executive, may still leave a puzzle to solve, while just a few minutes of “art speak” from their interior designer immediately brings a design solution to mind.

Each entrance project that Preston Studios has created results from the interface between the exterior architectural elements of the home and the interior design and taste of the owner. Much also depends on the materials available and which bevels/bevel sets will work in a particular situation. The intent is to create a unique “sense of arrival” in each.

For baths, the primary purpose is to create privacy. From that point on, anything is possible from abstract to full-on nature studies. At times, a bath may have design elements that speak to design. At others, the stained glass piece is the focal point statement.

Numerous other locations in the home lend themselves to stained glass, whether it be a stairwell window, an oddly placed window in any room, or kitchen cabinets. It can be merely a decorative element or a fine art focal point. The reality of the matter, however, is that creating stained glass creations for residential clients can be a full-time occupation with many different means for making a living. Nothing is more fun than completing an installation and having the patron or client be ecstatic over the result!



Art Femenella, Recipient of the 2022 AGG Joseph Barnes Award

Established in 2008, the AGG Board of Directors set the wheels in motion to create an award for an outstanding member of the stained glass community. Finding Creative Solutions

The survival of the body is possible. The survival of the spirit is more difficult. These are the nuanced feelings evoked when viewing the work of glass artist Geoffrey Bowton. A former soldier himself, having served in the U.S. Army, Bowton signed up during the economic recession in 2008. His civilian experience in the sheet metal industry of the Pacific Northwest made him an excellent candidate for his position. He was deployed to Iraq in 2009 and 2010 followed by Afghanistan in 2011 and 2012. It was there that he found himself needing to craft creative solutions for his job but also for his spirit.

Contagion Series: lost components, boots
“A soldier will take each step vigorously marching forward toward the conflict that remains, walking into death’s very own backyard, inserting themselves into a war at great personal risk and sacrifice. Each time I connect with these boots, they serve as a vivid reminder of past experiences.”



"I'm not sure if I had a specific interest in art as a kid the way I did with creativity," Bowton shared. "In my early years as a nineteen-year-old sheet metal worker, I used skills to produce creative solutions, solving problems within the industry and commercial work. That is what led me to utilize my construction skills for the U.S. Army while being deployed to Afghanistan to solve problems and find creative solutions for living quarters, gear racks, office equipment, desks, and the like. That's the grassroots of where my art began. I decided to then start collecting materials and objects for fun, composing them to reflect the iconography of the army and my surroundings. It's what I did to stay alive in spirit while living and fighting in a combat zone. I started to make artistic things to feel like I could mentally survive."

Creating Powerful and Respectful Art

The duality of survival coupled with the burden it can place on a person's soul is present when you view the body of Bowton's work. He uses the technique of *pâte de verre* to create the delicate looking, sugary surface to show helmets, boots, gloves, and equipment all slightly blown away yet held together with string and metal staples. The work is powerful and respectful at the same time. It evokes the feeling of destruction, but only part way.

"Searching through deployment history becomes difficult with mental anxieties. The emotional content may shed light on deeper feelings and responses. I am seeking ways to discuss and relate what post-traumatic stress disorder means to me and the best ways I can recall or relate to it."

"Presented in the glass techniques of *pâte de verre*, I created a body of work that represents relics from the soldier's past. These *pâte de verre* vessels hold distant combat memories, which have been transformed to investigate the various struggles of my veteran life, post service."



“The work generates conversation without needing context to read,” says Bowton. “Viewers seem to understand the work having its very own evocation, and they want to discuss military histories or current affairs. For me, in those moments, I get to hear many unique perspectives of what the military and war mean to them, how it effects things, and so on. I feel that it becomes a strong and needed conversation.”

Bowton does not want to pontificate as much as he wants to connect. “The objects seen out of context can ignite the veteran mind. I am experiencing mostly positive connections about past histories. People like to explain what service meant, what values were kept, and what things they wish they could get back. It certainly raises awareness to other veterans that someone is digging into the ideas of the military through art.”

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



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

Drawing Inspiration from Personal Experience

When asked about mentors or artistic leaders, Bowton nods to his own personal experience as the motivation for creating work. “I think for me, it was mostly about survival and understanding. I was asking myself many questions: Who else is expressing themselves like I am? What artists live in the same mental space that I do? Who will be there to understand why I create this work and understand my need for social connection through art? Why do I express myself in this way?”

“There are many reasons that drive me to make work. I have tried to understand myself and unpack evidence from those lived experiences. What stands out the most is that my work connects me to people. I can see what viewing the glasswork did for them and how it gave someone a reconnection to a memory or person

post service. Perhaps there are family members who connected to someone they knew and lost, then when viewing the glasswork they were not alone. We all have suffered post 9/11, one way or another. We all share the same fight, but the work has a different effect for most everyone. I make art to survive and to help others feel that they can too.”

To that end, Bowton hopes to continue creating work that fosters that connection between soldier and civilian and all those touched by war. “The responses are to keep going, to keep sorting through the narratives, to keep moving on. The incredible power of craft and the sculptural capabilities of *pâte de verre* provide a common thread to trauma-related events. Visceral ideas instilled from the object are also known to help shape brain dynamics and cognition and offer a way to remember memories and access the intangible mind.”


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Adding to the Arsenal

Bowton is currently working on pieces to be housed in an exhibition at the Bainbridge Arts and Crafts Gallery at 151 Winslow Way E. in Bainbridge Island, Washington. The exhibition is slated for November 2022 just in time for Veteran's Day. The newer work will include weaponry.

"I am working on some upcoming pieces that will incorporate a few different types of weapons. It is expensive to mold, so I have been searching for ways to work around that. I am hoping to include those works in the fall exhibition and perhaps something sooner, depending on exhibition needs and calls. I now have two new weapons in the studio, and I'm preparing to make waxes of those soon. The new weapons are discussing mental health, war time, and homeland concerns.

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

Janis Miltenberger

Lampworking

40+ Years Experience in Glass Art

I find that my imagery is somewhat fixed. I have a style, and try as I might to deviate, it always finds me. There are many things to consider when I work, whether in repetition or artistically. For example, borosilicate glass comes to me in tubing and rod form, and I do not have easy access to molten boro. The form of my raw materials imposes some limits on the overall look and density of a given artistic work. Economic conditions also play a role. I must consider whether the art can be sold. Can it be shipped in a safe way and in a way that does not break the bank? These outside structures, materials, and economics are somewhat equal partners in both innovation and repetition.

Fulfillment comes from both artistic exploration and repetition. I work in series, exploring ideas and practical approaches in how I make my work. There is a peace and rhythm to production work, and I really enjoy the quiet focus that repetition provides. I am starting to explore some new techniques, however, and I am curious to see if this will influence my personal style.

Nina Casson McGarva

Kiln Cast Glass Manipulated Hot
15 Years Experience in Glass Art

I like to work on the edge of what is technically achievable, pushing the possibilities of the material and my skills. I've learned to be emotionally strong, because a lot of my work fails before I get it to succeed. I have a comfortable groove that serves me, but I'm always pushing the technical limits. If I stop pushing, I wouldn't feel that the possibilities were fulfilled. The challenge keeps me interested. I cannot make two pieces the same. Even if I try, I physically can't, which makes it quite difficult to do commissions. The way I work makes the final result quite unpredictable.

The subjects of my work are usually the same, illustrating my love for patterns in nature. I was lucky to be surrounded with nature growing up. We didn't have neighbors, and being by myself surrounded by nature is where I feel the most comfortable. I don't have to talk. I can just appreciate what's around me and contemplate. I'm quite an introvert. I like being alone in my own world. Also, in my way of working, I like to be comfortable in my space with things I like. It's my safe place and an inspiring one.



Caterina Urrata Weintraub

Flameworked and Blown Glass
18 Years Experience in Glass Art

To me, repetition creates the space for innovation. While I understand that for some artists these things can be very separate, for me, they go perfectly together. Glass is such a difficult material to work with. Even the most simple techniques can be incredibly difficult to master and repeat in a consistent manner. I believe repetition is absolutely necessary to gain proficiency.

Glass artists can, and often do, spend their entire careers mastering and refining specific techniques so they can bring their visions to life. While sacrificing creativity for practice may be limiting for some, I find it inspiring! I have discovered that once I gain the basic knowledge and ability of a specific technique needed for a piece, I am able to play with the process and innovate. I can better understand the limitations of the material and push them. This may sometimes result in failures, but mostly it opens up new ways of thinking and seeing.

Shane Fero

Blown Glass

31 Years Experience in Glass Art

I was 15 years old when I started as an apprentice to a family of flameworkers under Jerry and Lee Coker and later under Roger Smith near Cypress Gardens, Florida. On weekdays and weekends after high school, I was taught simple procedures with glass on a torch, and I would repeat them over and over again to gain competence. This form of instruction and practice was to be my mode of education going forward for many years. It enabled me to learn to produce many glass items and trained my hands and mind to make it happen. Since I had keys to the shop, sometimes I would go in at night to practice or try something new to improve my skills.

After eight years of being an apprentice and a journeyman, I had substantially improved my skills. I opened a gallery, Classical Glass, at age 24 in Plattsburgh, New York, where I went to college. Suddenly, I had complete freedom and could create what I wanted with no constraints from my bosses. That was a period of exploration and innovation. It didn't mean that every time I made something, it was completely new. My creations were always based on what I had previously made, perhaps with a new twist.

Many artists do produce completely new things almost every time with different materials or concepts, but others, like musicians, produce bodies or series of works based on a theme with variations. My main bodies of work over the years have been goblets, perfume bottles or spirit vessels, figurative surrealistic sculptures, shadow boxes, and large furnace/flameworked bottles and teapots. I have made my blown series of birds for 20 years now. Each one is different and leads to another variation or novel idea. The focus is on the form, color, and gesture with an evolution of ideas or themes. No two are alike.

With my bird series, I use the same basic procedures with variations to make each one. What is different are the colors and pattern, the amount of glass that I use depending on the form, the gesture or pose, the beak, the eyes, and subtle differences. Those things make each one unique. Although they are based on repetition, there is a constant innovation on each bird produced. That is why people collect them over and over again, and I never get bored. **GA**



From its humble beginnings 25 years ago, CGS has developed into a thriving and proactive society supporting a membership of over 1,100 British and international contemporary glass artists. To celebrate our quarter century representing and promoting contemporary glass, we are delighted to be showcasing a special celebratory three-month-long exhibition entitled *CGS at 25: Past, Present, the Future*, hosted by the new Stourbridge Glass Museum. The exhibition began on July 23 and will continue through October 30, 2022.

Twenty-Five Years of Change

The past 25 years have seen dramatic political, technological, environmental, and social changes and advances. 

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


Looking to the Future
